


Company Default Mortality Settings

There are 4 settings in Company Defaults that you can use to affect your Mortality Alerts and control groups that are displayed on the Mortality App.

Mortality Alert Defaults

Mortality Alert Threshold – This is the percent over the Mortality Curve % expected mortality that you want to receive the Alert email. If you would like to receive the Alert once the Mortality Curve % is hit for any given week, you can set this to zero. Note: you cannot leave this blank or alerts will not go out.

*You will receive the Alerts (providing the Threshold is met) on a Group Week (think WOF) and not a calendar week. For example, if the threshold is met on a given day, you will receive an Alert. Once the Group Week rolls into the next Group Week for that group, you will receive an Alert as soon as the threshold is met again. In certain instances, this could even be the next day.

*You will receive only one Alert per Group Week even if the threshold is met on consecutive days of that Group Week.

Mortality Alert Minimum Mortality to Notify – Mortalities will need to be greater than this number in order to receive an alert.

Mortality Update Limits – This is where you can designate how far back users can Delete and Edit on the Mortality App. Choices are:

Prevent Updates after 7 Days – Can go back 7 days from current day.

Prevent Updates After Production Week Completed – Can only go back as far as the beginning of the current production week as defined by your company Production Calendar (Setup, Company Attributes, Production Calendar).

Include Groups Without Inventory – If you would like new groups that do not yet have inventory (first movement into the group has not been done yet) you can check this box to have them show up on the Mortality App.

Exclude Pending Close Groups – This will allow you to stop sending a group to the Mortality App if a new group of pigs have started in the barn. This eliminates mortality being entered into the old group, even though the group is gone from the barn physically, it may still be in MetaFarms as an active group. For the most part they will be at zero inventory but not yet had the final movements out of the group that would normally remove them from the Mortality App.

Each group has to be flagged as Pending Close so that it will not show up on the app once you have this box checked. This flag can be found in the Details button of the Group Edit, Finish, Find a Group. Search for your group. Click the Details button.

Enable Room Entry and Enable Pen Entry – Click Enable Room Entry if you would like this field to show up on the app. Once clicked, then you will see the option to click Enable Pen Entry. Check this if you would like Pen to show on the app. Note – you can have only Room Level show, but not only Pen Level.
