

New Movement

Movements are how you move your pigs into groups, transfer pigs to other groups, and sell the pigs. The From/To Prefix, Entity, and Event Code choices have been previously set up in Enterprise Manager. You may have a movement with more than two rows. For example: pigs sold to multiple plants or being split into multiple groups.

There are many optional fields that you may choose to use or not use, depending on the type of movement you are creating. Some Examples are:
 When moving pigs from a nursery group to a finish group, you may want to include the weight of the pigs and also the cost of the pigs.
 When selling cull pigs you may want to include the dollars you received for those pigs and also the trucking company. (See procedure for Entering Cull Sales)
 The options are many and should be determined during your implementation. You also have the option of hiding unnecessary columns that your company will not be using. To do this contact Customer Support.

The first row of a movement will be where the pigs are coming from. For Example: sow unit, pig supplier, or group. This is entered as a negative number
 The second row of a movement will be where the pigs are going. For Example: plant, customer, or another group. This is entered as a positive number

This is an example of moving pigs from a Pig Supplier to a Group. Note fields with a (*) are required. Other fields are optional

11. Save

Save (Ctrl-S) Post (Ctrl-U) Add Rows: Add (Ctrl-A)

1. Movement ID will autofill

3. Enter your From Prefix.
(for instructions on using column headers to search, see below)

4. Enter your from Entity

5. Enter the correct Event Code

6. Enter number of pigs coming From the Supplier as a Negative

2. Fill in your movement date

7. Enter your to Prefix

8. Enter your To Entity
(for instructions on using the Group searchbox, see below)

9. Event Code will autofill when you tab thru it

10. Enter number of pigs going to the Group

**Note: If you know the From/To Prefix, From/To Entity, and Event Code, you can type them in. You are not required to use the search boxes.

To use the pop up box to fill in the fields, put your cursor in the field you want to fill in and click on the Category Header:
For example: If you wanted to choose the From/To Prefix, this is what you would do:

Save (Ctrl-S) Post (Ctrl-U) Add Rows: Add (Ctrl-A)
