Column A – Is your Sow Unit Code and is required.

Column B – Is the Sow ID and is required.

Column C – Is the Heat Date and is required. Format must be the same as the example.

Column D – Is the Tech.

Column E - Is the Crate It is optional and must match the Crate Code in your setup.

Column F - Is for future use.

Column G – Is for Backfat. It is optional and must be a number.

Column H – Is for Weight. It is optional and must be a number.

Column I – Is for Heat Strength. It is optional and must match the Heat Strength Code of 1 (high), 2 (medium) or 3 (low)

Column J – Is for Boar Exposure Date. It is optional and must be in the same format as the example

Column K – Is for Time of Day. It is optional and must be in the format as the example.


Column L – Is for future use.

Column M – Is for Comments. It is optional and can be a series of letters and numbers.


Once you have your abort import file created, you are ready to import.






- **If the correct number of rows did not upload, check your file for missing or invalid information. If you need to correct the file and upload again, you will need to rename the file. You will also need to delete the previous incorrect file. You can do this by clicking Search Unposted and clicking Delete on the row of your import.
- ** Note you will not be able to delete it once it has been Posted.
