

Mortality Alerts

Mortality Alerts may be set up so individual users can receive an email if the mortalities for any given group exceeds either the Estimated Weekly Mortality from the Mortality Curve, or a company defined Threshold % above the mortalities expected per the Mortality Curve.


Alerts may only be sent if the following criteria is met:

- Your company must be set up to Allow Mortality Threshold Notifications. Contact Customer Support for this step.
- The group is Active and has a Mortality Curve and Estimated Mortality % set up. See section below for setup procedures.
- The user is set up to receive the alerts. See section below for User Setup procedures.
- The Threshold % Level is set up in Company Defaults. See section for Mortality Alerts setup.

Group Setup for Mortality Alerts

Groups will be set up like normal (see procedure on Help menu for full setup). To set the group up for Alerts, you can select the Pig Flow if you have the Pig Flow set up with the defaults for Mortality Distribution and Estimated Mortality % for that flow. (See procedure for Pig Flows)

If you do not have it set up to default, you can choose the Mortality Distribution from the dropdown. (see procedure for Mortality Curves). Then fill in the Estimated Mortality % for the group.

User Setup

Once MF has created the user, the Super User for your company can complete setup for the user to receive Alerts. The Super User will use their normal login and the link provided to the [Mobile Security](#) web page.

Click on the [User Security](#) tab and you will see your User list. Click the [Apps](#) button next to the User you want to add. Click [Preferences](#) on the Grower App line.

At the bottom of the form are 'UPDATE' and 'CANCEL' buttons.

Allow Delete and Allow Edit – turning these on will give the User the ability to Delete and/or Edit mortalities based on the [Company Default](#) selection of Mortality Update Limits. Prevent Updates after 7 Days will allow only Delete or Edit within the last 7 calendar days. Prevent Updates After Production Week completed will all Delete or Edit only in the current production week as defined by your [Production Calendar](#).

Company Defaults

Reference ID – This will show on the app as additional information for the group. You can make the selection of what you want that reference to be. Options are Business Unit, Animal Flow, POD, Market Contract, Health Plan and Animal Source. This is for additional helpful information about this group of pigs.

Entry Frequency - These are for the actual entering of mortalities. This makes entry dates available weekly or daily and affects if you receive an email reminder to enter mortality daily or weekly.

Reminder Email - A reminder email will be sent if the User does not enter the mortality on the Entry Frequency selected, either Daily or Weekly. You can set the Reminder Time and Day that the email will be sent. Note the email that will be used for this Reminder is the email provided when the user is set up in MF.

Receive Mortality Alert – This will create an Alert email that will be sent if the group has exceeded its designated mortality %. Again, in order to receive these alerts you must have the Threshold % set up in Company Defaults.

This Threshold % is the trigger of when to send the Alert email. In this example, it would be 10% over the mortality % expected for that week for the group. It can be set to 0 if you want to receive the Alert when the expected mortality % from the group is hit.

Receive Mortality Alerts - Select this dial and enter the Mortality Alert Email that the Alert should be sent to. Note this email is not the same as the Reminder email. (You do not need to fill in the Cell Phone sections).

Weight, Reason, Type – Select these dials if you would like it these to be required for data entry on the App.

Number of Dead Treated Animals and Number Treated- This feature is not associated with Mortality Alerts.

Click Update to save your choices.

Note: The Mortality App Users will also have the ability to set up their Alert emails in the app. They can go to the menu (3 bars in the upper left) and turn on Alerts and enter their email.

Farm/Site

Once the Preferences are set for the user, click Back and then Farm/Site. Turn on the Sites the user should have access to on the Mortality App.
